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DETAILED MODALITIES ON QUALIFICATION AND OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR TEMPORARY ENGAGEMENT OF FACULTY MEMBERS IN DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS OF DHARANIDHAR UNIVERSITY

I) FOR THE POSTS OF PROFESSORS AND ASSOCIATE PROFESSORS:

Eligibility:

- The vacant posts of Professor and Associate Professor will be filled up on temporary basis by retired Associate Professors/Professors/Adjunct Professor/Emeritus Professor/Professor of Practice etc. only. No guest faculty will be allowed against these posts.
- The Adjunct Faculty and the Professors of Practice will be selected as per existing UGC Guidelines.
- The retired teachers could be from any Govt. Aided or Private Higher Education Institution of the Country possessing appropriate qualification prescribed by UGC for different categories.
- Retired teachers below the age of 70 years are eligible to apply for the above posts.

Honorarium:

- Rs. 50,000/- per month for Professor (at least 35 classes per month and guidance in research work including administrative responsibility).
- Rs. 40,000/- per month for Associate Professor (at least 35 classes per month and guidance in research work including administrative responsibility).
- No other allowances or financial benefits shall be allowed in favour of the retired teachers/guest faculty.
- If less than prescribed classes are undertaken by retired faculties, the honorarium shall be given proportionately or shortfall shall be adjusted against workload of immediate next month.
- The Honorarium for Adjunct Faculty and the Professors of Practice will be limited as per the maximum monthly honorarium limit as detailed above. In addition, for Adjunct Faculty or Professors of Practice visiting from outside the jurisdiction of the university, applicable TA will be provided in addition to free guesthouse facilities at the University which will be borne by the University.

II) FOR THE POSTS OF ASSISTANT PROFESSORS:

Eligibility:

Against the vacant posts of Assistant Professors, both retired Assistant Professors and fresh/in-service candidates having requisite qualifications can apply.

Qualifications for fresh candidates:

- 1) A good academic record with a minimum of 55% of marks (or an equivalent grade) at Master's Degree level in the relevant subject from a recognized University.
- 2) The candidates who have cleared NET in the relevant subject conducted by UGC/ CSIR or any other Agency recognized by the U.G.C. or holds M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree in the concerned subject or holder of any National-level Fellowship/ Scholarship shall be given preference.

Note:

A relaxation of 5% shall be given (i.e. 50% of marks instead of 55% marks) at Master's Degree level for the candidates belonging to SC/ST and differently-abled categories.

Honorarium:

- Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) per class (with Ph.D. qualification) [Max. 60 classes/month; Rs. 60,000/- Max.]
- Rs. 750/- (Rupees seven hundred fifty only) per class (without Ph.D. qualification) [Max. 60 classes/month; Rs. 45,000/- Max.]

No other allowance or financial benefit shall be allowed in favour of the Guest Faculty.

III) ADVERTISEMENT AND MODE OF FILLING-UP FOR THE POSTS:

- The posts shall be advertised in the following English and Odia dailies:
 1. The Times of India (English Daily)
 2. The Sambad (Odia daily)
 3. The Dharitri (Odia daily)
- All the categories of posts shall be filled-up through a duly constituted Selection Committee.
- The selection shall be made through evaluation of candidates based on the criteria fixed by the University as detailed at **Annexure – I & Annexure – II.**

Other Terms and Conditions (applicable for all categories of posts):

- The engagement will not confer any right to claim for the post on regular basis.
- The engagement will be for a maximum period of one year or till the vacancies are filled in regular manner, whichever is earlier.

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- The continuation of engagement shall be subject to satisfactory performance during the quarterly review.
- In case retired teachers are engaged, they can continue up to 70 years of age, subject to periodical review of satisfactory performance.
- The University can terminate without assigning any reason thereof. The University reserves the right to conduct or cancel the interview at any point of time. Legal disputes if any shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Keonjhar only. No TA and DA will be paid to the candidates for appearing the Interview. The date of interview shall be notified later and shall be communicated to all eligible candidates for the post of Assistant Professor. However, for the post of Professor and Associate Professor, the applications shall be evaluated by the duly constituted committee.

Eligible candidates for the post of Assistant Professor are required to carry the following documents at the time of interview:

1. The original Certificates and Mark sheets in support of their academic qualifications along with a set of self-attested photocopies of those documents.
2. Evidence of academic achievements, such as, Ph.D./M.Phil./^{NET/}Dissertation publications/books published/participation in Seminars/Conferences/Workshops, etc. and awards won may also be produced before the Selection Committee.
3. Two sets of Bio-Data with full particulars containing address for correspondence, telephone number, mobile Number and e-mail address etc.
4. Two nos. of recent passport size Photographs.
