1. Introduction

Dharanidhar University (hereinafter called the University) is going to conduct Entrance Test-cum-Dharanidhar University Research Eligibility Test (DURET) for enrolment of students into the Ph.D. Full-time programmes in the regular P.G. Departments sanctioned by State Government/UGC for the academic session 2026-27.

- ***No candidate with unsatisfactory conduct or having criminal antecedent(s) shall be considered for admission.***
- ***Mere qualifying in the Admission Test-cum-DURET does not confer any right to claim admission into any of the Ph.D. Programme.***
- ***The admission to any of the Ph.D. Programme shall be subject to availability of eligible supervisor and seats as per the existing Regulations.***
- ***Candidate must not be in any employment under Organization or Institution (Government/Private).***

The applicants before applying to any of the above programmes are advised to carefully go through this prospectus and visit the University Website (<https://dduniversity.ac.in>) to know about the profile of the University. They are also advised to visit the University Campus in Keonjhar if they desire so and see for themselves the available infrastructure and other facilities. If satisfied, they may apply to any of the courses as per their eligibility. Once admitted, making any unreasonable demand thereafter shall not be entertained and it shall be treated as an act of indiscipline.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Ph.D. (Doctor of Philosophy):

3.1 Programme Duration: 3 to 6 years

- (a) *Eligibility criteria for admission to Ph.D.:* Subject to the conditions stipulated in the Ph.D. Regulations of the Dharanidhar University, the following persons are eligible to seek admission to the Ph.D. programme: A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after

a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed.

or

4-year degree honors programme with research and having qualified NET for PhD

Or

Equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/SEBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the commission from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/SEBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

3.2) Candidates who have completed M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC and the State Government from time to time.

3.3) Candidates with requisite marks as above and having qualified in a national level examination conducted by UGC, CSIR, GATE, JEST, CAT, DBT, ICAR, ICMR, GPAT and other such equivalent and for those who have been selected for fellowship/scholarship for PhD such as INSPIRE, RGNF, ICCR, ICCSR, Exchange Fellowships, and other such equivalent National/State Fellowship/Scholarship shall have to appear only for the interview to be conducted by the respective

departments for PhD admissions along with Dharanidhar University Research Eligibility Test (DURET) qualified selected candidates. All others must qualify the Dharanidhar University Research Eligibility Test (DURET) followed by an interview.

4. ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

4.1 Admission for Ph.D. Programs shall be conducted by a two-stage process, as detailed below:

4.1.1. Stage I which is an Entrance Test (written test), namely **Dharanidhar University Research Eligibility Test (DURET)**, shall be conducted by Dharanidhar University before commencement of the academic year. Candidates, who have qualified in a national level examination conducted by UGC, CSIR, GATE, JEST, ICAR, ICMR, DBT, CAT, GPAT and other such equivalent and those who have been already selected for PhD fellowship/scholarship such as INSPIRE, RGNF, ICCR, ICCSR, Exchange Fellowships, and other such equivalents are exempted from taking the test. These candidates can apply to the University for PhD admission process along with the advertisement for DURET (The DURET advertisement shall clearly notify such candidates also to apply). PhD admission commences at DHARANIDHAR UNIVERSITY from the beginning of academic year only. National level qualified candidates shall get preference.

4.1.2. Stage II, an interview process, is compulsory for all candidates seeking admission for PhD programme at Dharanidhar University, in which the candidates shall be assessed for subject knowledge and aptitude for PhD work and discuss their tentative research interest/area before a duly constituted Department Research Committee (DRC). DRC shall select candidates for PhD as per the number of vacancies and research interest of the candidate.

4.1.3. After selection of the candidate for admission to PhD programme in the department, the DRC shall allocate a suitable supervisor to the candidate depending on his/her research interest and may suggest an alternative supervisor in case the faculty does not have enough slots for PhD guidance anymore or unwilling to supervise a candidate. The selected and successful candidate shall be offered admission only after a supervisor is allocated, based on mutual interest and consent of the candidate and supervisor. This process has to be completed at least one week before the PhD admission commences.

4.1.4. The candidates may contact a potential supervisor before the selection process commences and may show the consent letter to the selection committee.

4.1.5. Faculty members must encourage research students to be supervised by them or by others, and nothing else except merit, eligibility and reservation policy shall constitute the only criteria for selection. If at a later time, any unfair means/liaison is established, the registration of the candidate shall be cancelled with immediate effect, and the supervisor shall also be liable for appropriate punishment.

4.1.6. The number of final selected candidates shall be equal to supervisor allocated / showing willingness.

4.2. Candidates who have already cleared research entrance test and have completed pre-PhD course-work from any other national/ state universities or equivalent institutions within two years* from the date of advertisement for admission to Ph.D. Programme of DDU can take admission into PhD programme by applying in prescribed format, provided the candidate must get a consent letter from the supervisor and approval of the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) after synopsis presentation. In such cases candidate need not appear in the DURET or Viva-Voce examination.

*(*students who have completed their coursework earlier at the second campus, MSCB University before the merger of its second campus with Dharanidhar University and are working with faculty members who have opted for Dharanidhar University may be allowed to register only after receiving a consent letter from their coursework-project supervisor. Their date of admission/enrollment will be the same as that at the second campus, MSCB University and they will only be allowed to submit their thesis after three years of minimum residence period as per rule. This is a one-time provision keeping in view the interest of scholars. It cannot be cited as precedent in future.)*

5. **PhD through Part-time mode:**

5.1 PhD programme through part-time mode will be permitted, provided all the conditions stipulated in these Regulations are fulfilled.

5.2 Candidate applying for admission into a Ph.D. programme (in part-time mode) must obtain a “No Objection Certificate” from the appropriate authority in the organization where he/she is employed, clearly stating that:

- i. The candidate is permitted to pursue studies on a part-time basis.
- ii. His/her official duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time to research.
- iii. If required, he/she will be relieved of the duty to complete the course work.

5.3 Students applying for part time mode must qualify DURET.

6. **Sponsored Programme**

6.1 Employed professionals desirous of applying for part time PhD Programme and sponsored by their employer are exempted from appearing DURET. However, their selection will solely be decided on the merit of their research proposal. All interested applicants must submit the research proposal for shortlisting. The shortlisted candidates will be called for interview for final selection. Such candidates are required to undergo the pre-PhD coursework.

6.2 At any point of time, the department can take a maximum of 20% of the slots as part-time students in the respective departments.

7. **Dharanidhar University Research Eligibility Test (DURET)**

- 7.1 Ordinarily all candidates have to go through the two-stage process for admission into Ph.D. Programme of Dharanidhar University.
- 7.2 However, candidates who have qualified in the UGC-NET (including JRF) /UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF) and qualified in SET/SLET / GATE /JEST/CAT / ICMR/DBT/GPAT/ Teacher-fellowship and other such equivalent tests shall be exempted from DURET qualification. Such candidates have to appear for the interview/Viva-Voce Examination to be conducted by the DRC.
- 7.3 After selection and admission, the candidate shall be assigned an Enrolment Number and a Certificate shall be issued by the Chairman, P.G. Council for the purpose of availing fellowship, if any. Such candidates have to complete Pre-PhD Course Work. Pre-PhD course work at Dharanidhar University is mandatory for all PhD registered students even if the candidate has M.Phil., MTech and other equivalent post-master's degree.
- 7.4 Dharanidhar University Research Eligibility Test (DURET) shall be of 100 marks out of which, 50% of the questions shall be devoted to research methodology (50%) and the rest 50% shall test the candidates' aptitude in their concerned subject. The DURET shall be conducted and notified by the Chairman, P.G. Council, Dharanidhar University. The number of DURET qualified candidates to be finally called for interview shall be **three times** (category wise and in alphabetical order of surnames of candidates qualified) of the number of PhD students to be granted admission in the department. Before the interview/viva-voce, each department shall notify the number of students they shall be able to provide admission to, if qualified candidates are available. The Department Head/Coordinator shall notify and obtain the information from all faculty members on the number of PhD available against each faculty and display it on website and department notice board. The category-wise availability also needs to be considered.
- 7.5 Candidates who have secured 50% mark in the entrance test are eligible to be called for interview.
- 7.6 A relaxation of 5% of marks (from 50% to 45%) in the entrance examination shall be allowed for candidates belonging to SC/ST/SEBC/OBC (Non-creamy layers)/ Differently abled category, and other categories of candidates as per decision of the commission from time to time.
- 7.7 If, in spite of the above relaxation, the seats allotted for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC (Non-creamy layers)/ Differently abled categories remain unfilled, the University shall launch a Special Admission Drive, for that particular category in the next session for admission.
- 7.8 For DURET qualified candidates, 70% weightage to be given for the entrance test and 30% to the performance in the interview. In case of entrance exempted category, as mentioned in 7.2, the selection will be based on their performance in the interview only as per UGC guidelines.

7.9 Interview/Viva-Voce (30% marks to be given by the DRC Board)

The interview/viva-voce shall assess the candidates in the following aspects:

- Whether the candidate has adequate subject knowledge and competence for the proposed research work;
- Whether the proposed area of research can contribute to new/ additional knowledge;
- Whether the facilities for the proposed area of research are available at the PG department/ Research Centre, where the candidate wishes to pursue his or her research work

At the interview/viva voce, the DRC shall preferably adopt the following evaluation method. Academic degree points shall be computed as per the Prescribed Weightage provided on the table below with maximum score of 100 points.

7.9.1 CAREER MARKING:

(a) DRC shall adopt the following evaluation method for a score of 100 or any other appropriate method approved by the Syndicate from time to time

(i) Evaluation of the Application (Maximum Score = 40)

1) Academic standing of the candidate (Maximum Career Score = 20): Performance of the candidate at different levels starting from HSC/ 10+ determined from Career Score.

9. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

Candidates seeking admission into PhD programme of Dharanidhar University have to download application form available at <https://dduniversity.ac.in> and send the filled in form duly signed by the applicant, along with photocopies of all the required documents to the Chairman P.G. Council by Speed/Registered post only so as to reach on or before **17.06.2026**. **Applications received after the due date or incomplete in any respect will be summarily rejected. University authorities shall not be responsible for any postal delay.**

10. FEE TO BE PAID ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION FORM

Candidates seeking admission to various PhD Programmes of Dharanidhar University have to pay a **non-refundable** Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque of **Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only (Rs. /- 500 for SC/ST candidates)** towards Processing-cum-Application fee drawn in favour of the **REGISTRAR, DHARANIDHAR UNIVERSITY, A/C NO. 00000036980319831, IFSC Code: SBIN0000113, STATE BANK OF INDIA**, payable at Keonjhar. **No other form of payment is acceptable under any circumstances.**

Note: Processing-cum-Application Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

11. DOCUMENTS TO BE SENT ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION FORM

The applicant should send the following documents with his/her application form:

(1) Self Attested photocopies of:

- b) Certificates and Mark Sheets of all examinations from H.S.C. to master's degree.
- c) Certificate of teaching experience, if any.
- d) Copies of publications, if any.
- e) Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended.
- f) No objection certificate from the employer, if employed.
- g) Certificate in support of his/her claim against reserved seats (SC/ST/SEBC) issued by competent Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tahsildar.

(2) One self-addressed envelopes of size 22 × 10 cm each affixed with postage stamps for Registered post.

12. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

After receiving the Intimation Letter for admission, the candidates shall send the following, superscribing

- (b) Three recent coloured Passport Size photographs.
- (c) **T.C./College/University Leaving Certificate in original.**
- (d) Conduct Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- (e) University Registration Receipt in original (in case of students of Dharanidhar University).
- (f) Migration Certificate (in case of students of Universities other than Dharanidhar University). If this certificate cannot be submitted at the time of admission due to any genuine difficulty, the candidate should give an undertaking to the effect that he/she would produce it within a Month from the date of admission, failing which the admission may be treated as cancelled.
- (g) Relieve Order in original from the Employer for one year, if he/she is employed.
- (h) A self-addressed envelope of size 22 × 10 cm affixed with postage stamps worth Rs.40/- (Rupees Forty only).
- (i) Certificate from a recognized Medical Practitioner indicating Blood Group of the applicant.
- (j) Duly filled in prescribed Affidavits (Annexure – I & II) in non-judicial stamp paper in original are to be submitted, if admitted.
- (k) Duly filled in Identity Card in the enclosed Format with a passport size photograph affixed thereof, if admitted.

The candidate shall submit the following declaration:

shall forfeit my seat, my admission shall be cancelled and I shall be liable for such other penal action, as the University may deem appropriate

13. RETURN OF DOCUMENTS

13. HOSTEL FACILITIES

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- (b) It is compulsory for hostel boarders to pay the monthly mess charges as determined by the Hostel Superintendent. The bill for every month has to be settled by the 10th of the succeeding month. Violation of the Hostel Rules or any default in regular payment of mess and other hostel charges shall lead to the termination of boardership.
- (c) The results of the defaulting boarders shall be withheld, if the certificate of clearance in respect of payment of mess dues etc. issued by the Hostel Superintendent concerned is not produced before the Controller of Examinations at the time of finally leaving the hostel or publication of results, whichever is earlier.
- (d) Boarders shall abide by the rules of the hostel prescribed from time to time by the University. In all matters pertaining to the hostels, the decision of the Warden, P.G. Hostels shall be final.

14. CORRESPONDENCE AND ENQUIRY REGARDING ADMISSION

All correspondence regarding admission should be addressed to the Chairman, PG Council/Head/Coordinator of respective departments Dharanidhar University, Keonjhar – 758001, as the case may be, by designation and not by name.

15. GENERAL RESTRICTION

No candidate who is in any service shall be admitted unless he/she submits relieve order from the employer allowing him/her leave for at least one year to pursue the Ph.D. coursework.

16. REGISTRATION

Every candidate for the Ph.D. Degree in Arts, Science and Commerce shall submit his/her application in the prescribed form for registration as a candidate for the examination within three months from the date of admission.

17. DISSERTATION

Each student shall be required to submit the Ph.D. thesis as per the Ph.D. Regulations of Dharanidhar University. The student has to bear all expenses incurred in the preparation of the thesis.

18. ADHERENCE OF RULES

- (a) The Ph.D. scholars of the University must abide by the Rules and Regulations framed by the University from time to time.
- (b) All disputes concerning admission and studentship are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Civil Courts and Legal Fora at Keonjhar, Odisha.

19. **RAGGING**

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Severe action shall be taken as per rules against those involved in ragging. As per the UGC guideline 6.1 (d & e) of the regulation (F-1-16/2007 (CPP –II/dated 17June 2009), it is mandatory for all the applicants to submit an online affidavit, if admitted.
